

ORDINANCE 16-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 105 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO SOLID WASTE COLLECTIONS FOR NON-RESIDENTIAL GENERATORS AND ESTABLISHING FEES THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARION, IOWA:

Section 1. Section 105.05 of the Code of Ordinances is amended by deleting subsection 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1. The Public Services Department shall provide for the collection of properly contained, bundled or placed solid waste, feedstock, yard waste and recyclable materials from all designated domestic and commercial generators located within the City of Marion. The collection of solid waste, feedstock and recyclable materials by the Public Services Department from generators located within the City of Marion is mandatory. The Public Services Department may enter into contracts with haulers for purposes of solid waste, feedstock, recyclable material and/or yard waste collection.


Section 2. Section 105.13 of the Code of Ordinances is amended by adding the following new subsection:

10. Commercial Service Rates. Upon approval by the Public Services Board, the Public Services Department may provide for the collection of feedstock from nonresidential generators. Rates for collection shall include provisions for a furnished collection bin provided to the generator. Rates for monthly commercial service collection are established as follows:


96 gallon container	\$ 20.00 per month
2 yard dumpster	\$ 82.50 per month
3 yard dumpster	\$ 96.50 per month
10 yard container	\$190.00 per month


Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final passage approval and publication as provided by law.
