

ORDINANCE 14-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 99 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO DOMESTIC USER SEWER CHARGES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARION, IOWA:

Section 1. Section 99.02 of the Code of Ordinances is amended by deleting subsection 2 of the same and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

2. Domestic User Charge. The user charge whose average waste contribution is less than 60,000 gallons per month and BOD of less than 250 mg/L, and suspended solids less than 250 mg/L, and oil and grease less than 100 mg/L and whose discharge contains no waste referred to in Section 97.03, is classified as a domestic user. The domestic user charge shall be \$1.95 per 100 cubic feet of water used for all customers.

A. For all customers with one-inch (1") or smaller water meters, this user charge shall only be charged for the first 6,000 cubic feet of water used per two-month billing period.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as by law provided except that the revised Domestic User Charge set forth in subsection 2 of section 99.02 shall become effective October 1, 2014. Violations of this Ordinance shall be punished as provided in section 1.06 of the Code of Ordinances.
