

ORDINANCE 12-08

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SELLING, PEDDLING AND SOLICITING IN A CITY PARK OR ON THE ADJACENT SIDEWALKS WHEN THE PARK IS RENTED OR RESERVED FOR A SPECIFIC EVENT AND PROVIDING PENALTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARION, IOWA:

Section 1. Section 122.06 of the Code of Ordinances is amended by adding the following new subsection:


10. It shall be unlawful for any person, whether licensed under this chapter or not, to sell, peddle, or solicit any person to purchase any article or service whatsoever in a public park or on the sidewalks adjacent to said park on both sides of the right-of-way, when that park has been rented by or reserved by a person or organization for a specific event and that event is taking place.

This section does not apply to: the sale of newspapers; vendors approved to be in the Park by the Park Board or approved by the person or organization having rented or reserved the park. This section also does not apply to any business located within the central business district that has a written encroachment agreement with the city provided that its activities are restricted to the area directly adjacent to its business; or to any business located within the central business district during a city approved sidewalk sale provided that its activities are restricted to the area directly adjacent to its business.

Central business district as used in this section means: the area north of 6th Avenue; south of 8th Avenue; east of 9th Street and west of 13th street.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as by law provided. Violations of this Ordinance shall be punished as provided in section 1.06 of the Code of Ordinances.
