

Examination For Firefighter

Testing for the position of firefighter for the City of Marion, Iowa will be held on Saturday, October 25, 2008, starting at 8:00 a.m. The top 30 scoring candidates will be invited to participate in an agility test on November 1, 2008. Applications may be obtained between September 2, 2008 and September 26, 2008 from the City Clerk at City Hall, 1225 6th Avenue, Marion, Iowa.

Applications and supportive materials must be completed and submitted to the City of Marion City Clerk at 1225 6th Avenue, Marion by no later than 5:00 P.M., September 26, 2008.

Applicants must provide proof of current State or National certification as an EMT (Basic level minimum) to be eligible to take the test. All applicants must be in good physical condition and pass the examinations and standards of the Board of Trustees of the Civil Service Commission and the Municipal Fire and Police Retirement System of Iowa. All qualifications of Chapter 400 of the Iowa Code are applicable. The City of Marion is an equal opportunity employer.

Work often includes performing strenuous, hazardous tasks during emergency situations. In addition to firefighting, rescue, and EMS response, a firefighter maintains fire department property, equipment, apparatus and quarters. Additional time is spent training and studying modern firefighting, rescue, EMS, and code enforcement techniques.
