The plaza project is the exclamation point on many community visioning efforts, public master planning processes, and private investments that support a broader vision and have achieved great momentum throughout the community.

The project was endorsed by the State and awarded a \$3 million Destination Iowa grant in 2022. The anticipated construction start date is summer 2023. The plaza capital campaign will be active through Dec. 31, 2023, and includes sponsorship opportunities.
