Welcome to Online Registration & Reservations

Last fall we launched our online registration platform. We encourage you to set up your household account at www.cityofmarion.org/parks-recreation.Then view and register for all our programs with just a few easy clicks. For renters, we encourage you to use the online calendar for the facilities to view availability and reserve select facilities. Please note, some facilities still require in-person reservations.

HOUSEHOLD ACCOUNTS | Please make sure to set up your household account and add all family members to your account to make the registration and reservation process quick and easy for future use.

HOUSEHOLD CREDITS | If you ever need to cancel a registration you will have the option to take a refund or have the amount applied as a credit to your household account for future use. You will still need to contact the Parks and Recreation office for cancellation and refund requests.

TEXT ALERTS Be sure to include your mobile number on your account. This allows you to receive text alerts for program cancellations.

VOLUNTEER COACH REGISTRATION | Coaches can now register online for the program they wish to coach. Simply search for the "coach" option with the desired program listed after it and complete the registration process.

POOL MEMBERSHIPS | We are excited to roll-out a new pool membership system and the ability to now accept credit/debit cards at the pool. Look for more information by early spring.

NEW! RENTAL POLICY You are now able to rent facilities for the current calendar year as well as the next year. For example, you can now rent rooms and pavilions for all of 2021 (current year) and all of 2022 (next year). The full calendar year is opened each January. This is a significant change from the one-year policy that was previously in place.

YOUTH TENNIS LESSONS

Children Ages 5-16 | The Marion Parks and Recreation Department will once again offer youth tennis lessons as part of a partnership with Westfield Tennis Club. Classes are led by instructors who have been trained by highly qualified and certified tennis professionals. Kids will learn age-appropriate skills, fundamentals and terminology based on their class/age group. The intermediate group will work at a faster pace and is geared more towards middle/high school students. Minimum class size is four, maximum class size 10. New Year, New Technology!

With the implementation of new software, we will now be able to accept credit/debit cards for daily admissions and pool memberships. Concessions will still be cash only, but we are working towards upgrading that soon.

Swim Lesson Levels

Children Ages 4+ | The following guidelines will help determine which level best fits your child's swimming ability. All children are assessed at their first lesson and may be moved to a different level if necessary. If your child is between levels, please register for the lower one. Students learn many different skills at each level and may need more than one session at each level to pass. These lessons are available for children ages 4 and up.

Level 1: Students learn to fully submerge face and body, breathe rhythmically, experience buoyancy, float on front and back and swim on front and back using arm and leg actions.

Level 2: Students learn to float on front and back with glide, swim a combined stroke front and back, demonstrate rhythmic breathing, tread water and swim on side.

Level 3: Participants must be able to stand unassisted in 3 1/2 feet of water. Students learn front crawl with rotary breathing, back crawl, butterfly arm and leg motions, a kneeling or standing dive, survival float and retrieve a submerged object.

Level 4: Students work on strokes including front and back crawl, swim on side with scissor kick, elementary back, breaststroke and butterfly. They also learn diving, underwater swimming, surface dives and open turns on front and back.

Level 5: Students refine the front and back crawl, elementary back, breaststroke, butterfly and sidestroke. They also learn standing and shallow dives, pike and tuck surface dives and front and backstroke flip turns.

Level 6: Students refine strokes to swim with ease, efficiency, power and smoothness over greater distances. This level offers these personal emphasis options: personal water safety, fitness swimming, fundamentals of diving and lifeguard readiness.

Splash! Parent-child (18 months-2 years). Work together with your child in the water through various games and activities designed to prepare the child for structured lessons. *Limited number of spots available.*

Intro To Swim I For children age 3. Students learn to fully submerge face and body, breathe rhythmically, experience buoyancy, float on front and back, and swim on front and back using arm and leg motions. *Limited number of spots available*.

Intro To Swim II For children ages 10-14. Do you have an older child that has never learned how to swim? This class allows kids the option to learn the basics of swimming with kids their own age. Limited number of spots available.
