Online Account Reminders

View and register for programs with just a few easy clicks. Set-up your household account for you and/or your family at cityofmarion.org/parks-recreation and begin registering! For renters, we encourage you to use the online calendar for the facilities to view availability and reserve select facilities. Please note, some facilities will still require you to visit us in person to complete the reservation process.

HOUSEHOLD ACCOUNTS | Please make sure to set-up your household account and add all family members to your account to simplify the registration and reservation process in the future. Please verify all contact information is correct (phone number, email, address, date of birth, etc.)

HOUSEHOLD CREDITS | If you ever need to cancel a registration you will have the option to receive a refund or have the amount applied as a credit to your household account for future use. You must contact the Parks and Recreation office for all cancellation and refund requests.

VOLUNTEER COACH REGISTRATION Coaches can now register online for the program they wish to coach. Simply search for the "volunteer coach" option with the desired program and complete the registration process.

NEW! RENTAL POLICY | You are now able to rent facilities for the current calendar year and the following year. For example, you can now rent rooms and pavilions for all of 2021 and 2022. The following full calendar year is opened each January. This is a significant change from the one-year policy that was previously in place.

WAITLISTS | Please only add the participant to the class waitlist once and make sure it is the participant's name and not the parent/adult. We will do our best to accommodate people on waitlists within reason, however being on a waitlist does not guarantee a spot in that program.
