Recent Week(s):

- Storm sewer was installed, roadway and sidewalk paving occurred and pavement markings were painted in the 600 block of 9th Street. This work area reopened to traffic.
- Roadway and sidewalk paving occurred, pavement markings were placed and the 600 block of 10th Street reopened to traffic.

Looking Ahead:

- Paving of the concrete base is anticipated and the decorative brick pavers will be placed along the 600 block of 10th Street.
- Trees and plantings will begin to go in along 7th Avenue, in the 11th Street Plaza area and along 10th Street.
- Sod will be placed in the green space areas of the 600 block of 10th Street.
- Work will continue on the sidewalk improvements in front of the Broad & Main building. Brick pavers will be installed and two additional light poles will be setup.
- Light poles and pedestals will be mounted along the 600 block of 10th Street.
- Existing pavement will be removed in the north half of the 600 block of 9th Street and on 7th Avenue between 8th Street and 10th Street.
- Pavement subgrade preparation will occur and granular subbase is expected to be installed in the 600 block of 9th Street.
- Water main and storm sewer work will begin along 7th Avenue between 8th and 10th Streets.
