

UPTOWN IS GETTING AN UPGRADE

UPDATES:

Date: Oct. 12, 2022

Recent Week(s):

- Paving operations dominated the work for the past two weeks along 7th Avenue from 8th Street to 10th Street. The street mainline and portions of the parking areas, sidewalks and driveways were poured.
- Areas along 9th Street, from 6th to 7th Avenues, received backfill and topsoil.

Looking Ahead:

- Paving operations will likely be completed in the next two weeks. This includes the remainder of the parking areas, sidewalks, driveways and sub-slab for the brick pavers.
- Streetlight bases will be installed and the poles will be erected.
- Installation of brick pavers may begin near the end of the next two weeks.
- By the end of the month, expect to see final backfilling and sod being placed. The remaining trees, shrubs and pavement markings should also be installed.

- A ribbon-cutting celebration is being planned to mark the completion of the 7th Avenue Reconstruction & Streetscape project on Thursday, Oct. 27 at 4 p.m. in the North Plaza. The agenda includes brief remarks, a display of items that were found during construction and a warm cider toast. All are welcome to attend.
