# **PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITY**

### **Zoning Ordinance Activity:**

Amendments in process

- City-wide design standards held a public hearing, which will remain open through the approval process with anticipated approval in January 2023.
- Research has begun to implement a street tree ordinance for all new developments. Staff will be conducting preliminary research through January 2023.

### **COMMERCIAL BUILDING ACTIVITY**

The Building Department has 43 active commercial permits. 1 new commercial permit was issued while 3 were completed. There are a lot of inquiries on potential new projects, but most are concerned over the shortage of building materials and labor and cost of both. With this said it is still encouraging that we could have another very busy year.

Framing for Green Park Apartments and Marion Boulevard Apartments continues with both getting the roofs put on and getting the buildings enclosed. Tulip Tree apartment contractor has indicated that their project will start coming out of the ground in spring with the installation of the aggregate pier footings being completed.

# **CODE COMPLIANCE ACTIVITIES**
