







I am strongly opposed to being forced to utilize larger garbage containers. I do not have inside storage space available for larger garbage or recycling containers and will be forced to place them outside my home creating an unsightly situation. Also, provision of larger containers encourages residents to generate greater amounts of waste as opposed to reducing the amount that must be transported to the landfill every day. A transition to larger containers will drive costs either in direct collection fees or through increased taxes, neither of which are acceptable.

Our current garage can at our Marion house has been nearly destroyed by being tossed around by the garbage men (broken wheel, cracked rim, etc.) Our city-issued recycling bin had the lid get lost in the snow and then chewed up by our snowblower during a snowstorm. We greatly miss CR's durable containers (hearty and with an attached lid), and would like a system that could replicate the smoothness of CR's garbage collection.

What does automated collection vs manual collection even mean? What do we currently have? Bi-weekly can be read as either twice a week or every other week.

We should be able to put our a separate bin with glass to be collected just like the city of Cedar Rapids does.

I pay for it but feel like I don't get the service or a friendly Marion feel from it. I would cancel collections if my water was not a part of the fee. I have had negative experiences with my current service- non friendly. So I end up driving to the dump when I can at least once/twice a year to get rid of bulk items. Recycling rules are explained rudely with a tag so I almost completely refrain from using. I don't have a positive feeling towards current city collections. My ring camera has recordings of current city collections tossing my trash cans. I have a great relationship with my neighbors, we help each other, take care of elderly neighbors and pick up after collections are made. Let me express that I have never complained nor have I ever had a face to face conversation with collection. I have a much better relationship with my mailman.

Definitely need automated collection with larger standardized carts for both garbage and recycling. Also, I support continuing recycling every week rather than switching to bi-weekly. We have a large family and regularly fill up trash and recycling cans each week.

I would love bigger recycling containers that are wheeled!

I wish there was curbside collection for glass - not broken shards, just jars and bottles and stuff. Also, I hope the waste management workers who do all of this hard work collecting are being surveyed as well for their preferences and expertise.

It's extremely disappointing we can't curb recycle glass. People just end up not recycling it, and that's a shame. Or there's people like us who just have stacks of glass cluttering their garage because we never seem to find the time to take it in. Cutting down cardboard into 2' squares and binding is also frustrating when you have large boxes - you should just be able to take them if they are flattened. The yard waste rules are also unusually strict compared to Cedar Rapids - no sod/dirt, no grass clippings, sticks 1"+ cut and bound with twine.

Provide an option for glass recycling.

I think the current recycling system is fine. Maybe expand the times I can drop off glass or cardboard, or have a structure in place to allow drop off outside of current staffed hours

What improvements can be made without increasing costs for *all* residents? Are there different service levels that residents can pay for based on *their* needs, which don't increase the cost for everyone? For example, City water, we all pay a minimum amount and our cost increases based on the increased demand for water - can you leverage technology to make the same improvements in garbage/recycling programs to implement a similar scaling? Not everyone needs the weekly collection so they should not be taxed or forced to pay for an increase they won't use. Let those who want to pay for a service increase (whatever that looks like, more garbage or recycling levels/allowances) can pay for what improvements they want in their regular billing on a monthly or yearly basis. When they sell their residence, it service resets to the basic level service until the new resident wants to pay for an increase. Easy to implement with an iPad/kiosk or other device on each truck's collection route to know who has paid for increased service, and who may need to be billed for an occasional upcharge fee for exceeding the basic level on a case by case need. Hopefully that make sense!?

Concerned about how small our street is for winter pick up of both garbage and recycling and how placement of containers would be in snow filled right of way and streets.

Would be helpful to either not charge so much extra for cardboard in a special pickup, or allow larger cardboard sizes during weekly recycling pickup. For those of us that can't load large sizes of cardboard and take them to the recycling drop off, or are unable to safely use a box cutter to cut down larger sizes, it's difficult to get larger shipping boxes from Chewy or other retailers removed. Storing the cardboard for fewer special pickups attracts rodents and bugs.

Keep recycling center open 24 hours a day, self service. Use security cameras to prevent illegal dumping. START A KITCHEN COMPOSTING PROGRAM.

This survey does not ask the right questions. I am not unhappy at all with curbside garbage and recycyling in Marion. I like the convenience of being able to put out a bag instead of a can if I don't have very much or if I'm headed out of town and won't be able to bring my can and recycling tub back into the garage that day. On the other hand, Marion is long overdue to do something about yard waste. I hate putting grass clippings into brown paper bags and trying to fit weeds and pruning waste into my can with a Y on it. Packing leaves into containers is even worse. I do not have a truck or trailer to take them over to 35th Street. You didn't ask us if we have a place to store larger automated receptacles. I don't have space to store three large receptacles. I could put a large yard waste container in the back yard for infrequent use. I do not have space in my garage or side yard for two more large ones and I wouldn't relish the thought of having to transfer garbage and recyclables from smaller cans to the large ones every week. Finally, I hope you will finally extend the yard waste season. Not all the leaves are off the trees by the time yard waste collection ends in November.

We take glass to the city site occasionally. We have no way to transport yard waste to the facility. We are satisfied with our garbage and recycling service. We don't have room to store large garbage and recycling carts and don't want to pay more. We are not satisfied with our yard waste service. Have you considered changing only yard waste service? It is long overdue. Perhaps only the people who want that could buy a tag for it.

It would be so much better for poor employees that have to lift all those cans



How frequently do you use the City's Yard Waste Drop-Off Facility to get rid of yard waste or take compost?




