TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Always contact lowa One Call at 1-800-292-8989 before performing any digging.
- Trees must be in the *Superior* or *Allowed* categories of <u>The ReLeaf Cedar Rapids Plan's Master Tree List</u> to qualify for rebate. Exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis.
- When planting in the right-of-way, a Right-of-Way Tree Permit must be submitted to and approved by the Parks department prior to planting.
- Applications must be submitted within 30 days of purchase to qualify for a rebate.
- The Tree rebate program may be utilized up to three times per residential property.
- The maximum rebate per tree is \$50 not to exceed the price of the tree.
- Trees used to meet City of Marion landscaping requirements are not eligible for rebate.
- The applicant must be a City of Marion utilities customer.
- Applicant is solely responsible for purchase, planting, and care of trees planted on private property. Applicant is solely responsible for purchase, planting, and watering/early care of trees planted in right-of-way.
- Applications must be completed in full; incomplete applications may result in rebate denial.
- City staff will inspect planted trees prior to approving the rebate.
- Rebate checks will be issued to the account holder in existing buildings unless otherwise established prior to submission of application.
- Rebates may be subject to income tax. Consult your tax advisor for more information.
- Multi-family residences up to four units must be approved prior to rebate application. Multi-family residences of five units or more are not eligible for tree rebates.
- Rebates are subject to the availability of funds, applicants are encouraged to check the availability of rebate funding prior to making purchases.
- This program is subject to change or cancellation without notice.
- City of Marion acceptance of an application does not guarantee payment of rebate or acceptance of financing.
